The Fisogni Museum, founded in 1966 by the entrepreneur Guido Fisogni, hosts the largest collection in the world of objects relating to gas stations, including pumps, signs, compressors, oil cans, advertising graphics, toys, gadgets and projects that represent the evolution of the sector from 1892 until today. The collection is certified by the Guinness World Record.

THE AREAS OF THE MUSEUM



In this exclusive space, you can make your event unique and inimitable!










MULTIFUNCTIONAL ROOM

The main room, located on the first floor overlooking the courtyard, is the ideal space for indoor events and can host up to 240 people.

Equipped with air conditioning and lift, it is equipped with all services; a modern, bright and finely

renovated open space, which offers an excellent multifunctional location suitable for any type of event.













TENSILE STRUCTURE

Airy and bright, the tensile structure is 160 square meters large and is located in the middle of a green lawn, directly communicating with the garden and the other spaces of the Villa.

VILLA CASTIGLIONI FISOGNI

Villa Castiglioni Fisogni, dating back to the 18th century, is a beautiful example of an elegant Art Nouveau style estate.

Formerly the home of Cesare Castiglioni (soldier with Giuseppe Garibaldi), it is still inhabited by the heirs of the Castiglioni and Fisogni families.

Renovated in 2015, the area reserved for events offers a modern but at the same time elegant and evocative location.
